
Ambulatory EEG Cinch Bag—Smaller Size



You will need: Fabric cut to 12" x 22" 2 yards twill tape (5/8" or wider)

- 1. Cut fabric rectangle to measure 12" x 22".
- 2. Cut twill tape into two pieces, each 1 yard long.
- 3. Place bag, wrong side up on flat surface. Make a ¼" clip 4 inches from the top edge on all four side (longer) edges. Press ¼" to wrong side from clip to top edge: topstitch. Fold under top and bottom edges ¼", press.
- 4. Fold each pressed edge $1\frac{1}{2}$ " to wrong side and topstitch 1/8" from pressed edge to make a casing.
- 5. Thread one piece of twill tape through the casing going right to left in one and left to right in the other.
- 6. Repeat with the other piece of twill take being careful to go the opposite way thru the casing from the first piece.
- 7. Baste the ends of the twill tape to the fabric just above the bottom edge.
- 8. Place right sides together and stitch from clip to bottom edge, being careful to include tape ends in the seam, but not catch the loose parts of the tape in the seam. Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam.
- 9. Turn right side out, you are finished!
