

## MVQG Mystery Dinner Theater 'Sold Out'

If you didn't purchase your ticket early, you are out of luck. The Miami Valley Quilters' Guild production of "Shop Hop Mystery on the Paducah Star" is officially SOLD OUT!

This is the guild's third dinner theatre presentation. The first play was presented in May 2015 as a fundraising effort to supplement guild resources on a scale with the biennial Quilt Show held in even numbered years, and it was a tremendous success. Rather than pay royalties for a commercially available play for this year, a group of guild members wrote their own mystery script with a quilting theme. Following months of writing, casting, and rehearsals, cast and crew are ready to perform for a live audience,

The play will be performed for one night only at the Fairborn United Methodist Church, 100 N. Broad St, at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, May 14, taking the place of the regular monthly guild meeting.

In addition to enjoying a tasty meal and an exciting play, one member of the audience will also go home with a gorgeous quilt that was designed and constructed to be a significant part of the mystery. Audience members are invited to put their names on the back of their tickets and drop them in the appropriate container when entering the dinner theater. Some lucky person will go home with a gorgeous lap quilt (pictured above). Additional chances for the drawing, may be purchased for \$1.00 each or 6 for \$5.00 at the entrance to the dinner theatre. You must be present to win.



Although the May meeting has a limited audience of those who purchased tickets, we have a number of interesting meetings coming up.

## Upcoming Programs

Regular meetings will resume June 11 when our speaker will be Canadian quilter, designer, author and teacher Judy Martin. Judy has designed and published more original patterns than anyone in history. The list of Judy's quilt block designs is now at 1,063 and counting! She has posted a [31-page .pdf](#) on her website that lists all of her original patterns, plus when and where they were published. The list doesn't include any traditional patterns. She has made a four-decade career out of giving quilters the patterns, tools, and guidance to do their very best work.

The program will be highlighted by a trunk show of some of the outstanding quilts Judy has made from her original designs.

Becky Odom, history curator at the Ohio History Connection, will be our speaker for the July 9 meeting. She has a bachelor's degree in history from Haverford College and a master's degree in history museum studies from the Cooperstown Graduate Program. She earned her doctorate in American studies from Saint Louis University where her research and teaching focused on material and visual culture, clothing in American society and American cultural history from the Gilded Age to the Great Depression, particularly World War I, and German-American identity. She has worked extensively in museum education and collections with quilts, textiles and furniture at numerous museums.

The Ohio History Connection, formerly the Ohio Historical Society, is a statewide history organization with the mission to spark discovery of Ohio's stories. Chartered in 1885, the Ohio History Connection carries out history services for Ohio and its citizens focused on preserving and sharing the state's history. This includes managing more than 50 sites and museums across Ohio

Judy's presentation, "The Early History of Quilts through WWII", will include a PowerPoint presentation highlighting Ohio quilts from statehood through World War II


